Four Indicted for Trafficking in Drugs

A Preble County Grand Jury indicted four individuals on August 7, 2017 after detectives conducted a drug investigation into the trafficking of methamphetamine and heroin in Eaton. Two of the suspects have been located and arrested on these charges. Two more have not been arrested yet.

Nicholas B. Knaff, age 34 of Eaton, was indicted and arrested on the following charges:

- (2) counts of Aggravated Trafficking of Drugs, 3rd Degree Felonies
- (2) counts of Aggravated Possession of Drugs, 5th Degree Felonies

Each of these offenses occurred within 1000 feet of a school. Knaff is accused of selling methamphetamine during undercover buys. Knaff was arrested on August 8th and appeared in Preble County Common Pleas Court on August 9th. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.

Cheyla Woolums, age 20 of Eaton, was indicted and arrested on the following charges:

- (1) Count of Trafficking in Drugs, a 5th Degree Felony
- (1) Count of Possession of Drugs, a 5th Degree Felony.

Woolums is accused of selling heroin during undercover buys. She was already incarcerated in the Preble County Jail at the time of the indictment on drug related charges.

Detectives are in the progress of locating two additional suspects in this investigation.
